Fotoweeek Lecture Series at the Katzen Center featuring **Liza Faktor, Lincoln Schatz, and Alexandra Avakian**

DESCRIPTION: In this unique opportunity, three internationally renowned photographers will present their work, giving an insider's view of some of the most exciting photography being produced today.
